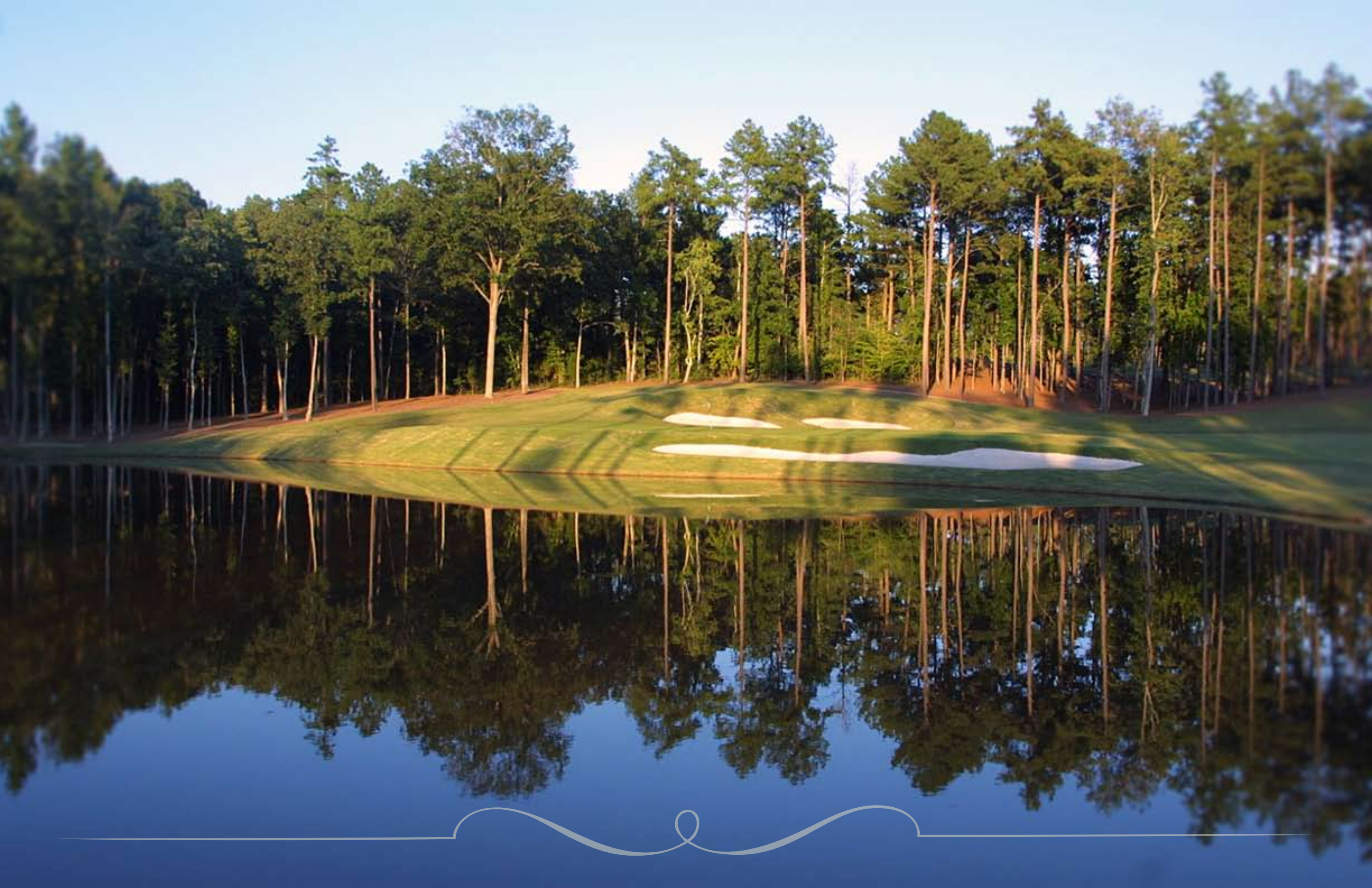

## *Introduction*

Old Chatham was born of a desire to return to the simple but deep traditions of the game.

In 1999, area business leaders began to take seriously their desire to establish a local club with the charm and character of the classics. These founders placed their vision in the hands of renowned golf course architect Rees Jones. With the shared belief that the best golf courses are those that let nature define them, the lines from tee to green remain much as they were before ground was ever broken.

In this secluded yet convenient location, Old Chatham members and their guests can escape to the tranquility of an uncrowded retreat, characterized by gracious hospitality with an emphasis on quality and comfort.

# *The Golf Course*

Chatham is a players course, maintained to championship standards, yet is a pleasure to play day-in and day-out by golfers with a wide range of skills. The best playing conditions will not be sacrificed in the name of aesthetics; instead we strive for dry, firm fairways that are both fast and tight. The bermudagrass rough will challenge an errantly struck golf shot. Putting surfaces are true; grain is absent. The subtlety of the greens challenge the most skilled golfers yet do not adversely penalize those with lesser qualifications.

The golf course and grounds are maintained with an exceptional attention to detail. A seamless combination of both modern and traditional maintenance practices gives the sense that the golf course at Old Chatham has been quietly in existence for many years.



## *Golf Amenities*

The practice facility at Old Chatham is comprised of 16 acres of hitting area with two tees and eight target greens, a short game area with practice bunker and a 6000 square foot putting green.

Old Chatham is one of the few courses in the region that maintains a caddie program. The use of caddies is a time honored tradition in golf and is an integral part of the playing experience at Old Chatham.



# *The Clubhouse*

Opened in late 2008, the Clubhouse has exceeded expectations. It is located on the highest point of the property and its gracious porch overlooks the 18th green. Designed with the sensibility of a fine private estate, it is the embodiment of understated elegance and comfort.



## *Access*

Located minutes from the I-40 and 540 corridors just outside of Research Triangle Park, Old Chatham's location on 400 acres of pine forest, surrounded by federally protected watershed area, gives players the impression they are miles away from the bustle of the outside world. The Club is centrally positioned between Raleigh, Durham and Chapel Hill, just 15 minutes from Raleigh-Durham International Airport.



## *Business Asset*

Members place tremendous value on the Club as a business asset. The seclusion and peacefulness provided by the golf course make it an ideal backdrop to conduct business, while the Clubhouse, with its private library for meetings and elegant locker room, provide for both formal and informal settings to either continue those dealings after the round or abandon them in favor of relaxation and camaraderie.



# Membership

Membership size is limited to ensure that members will always experience an uncrowded and peaceful golf retreat, yet new members are surprised at the attainability of Old Chatham. The golf course is reserved for member play only, and, while tee times are available, it is generally not necessary to reserve a tee time. The regular Saturday "Skins Group", and similar informal events during the week, ensure that new members will easily find opportunities to play. Limited membership size allows the staff at Old Chatham to anticipate and attend to the particular needs and requests of our members.
