## Tournament Schedule

The Golf Committee is excited to share our 2023 Important Dates & Event Schedule with you all. There is tremendous anticipation for this year's tournament schedule given the way the club debuted post renovation. The condition of the course is only going to get better and working with the Green Committee, the schedule has been crafted to ensure the conditions of the course can peak for each event.

## Member/Guest Events

The Golf Committee believes our Member/Guest events should be spotlight events. While different formats, it is the Committee's goal to make both The Hogan and The Rizzo equal in terms of stature, course conditions, and event features. We are looking to make significant enhancements to The Rizzo this year. For example, we will have the Greyson Airstream Van on property during the event this year.

This Family Guest rate will apply to specific extended family members: Father/Father-in-Law, Mother/Mother-in-Law, Son/Son-in-Law, Daughter/Daughter-in-Law, Grandparents and adult Grandchildren; all other extended relatives are considered full paying guests. Spouses and children of members under the age of 23 may still play as accompanied family guests without incurring a guest fee.

CART FEES \$20 per rider for 18 holes

\$12 per rider for 9 holes

PULL CARTS \$18 for 18 holes, \$12 for 9 holes

TEMPO WALKERS \$20 for 18 holes, \$12 for 9 holes

CADDIE FEE \$125 per bag carried for 18 holes

\$65 per bag carried for 9 holes

FORECADDIE \$250 (3-4 players) 18 holes

\$150 (1-2 players) 18 holes

\$50 per rider 9 holes
